 <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Oversized pile</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Household items examples:</b> Furniture, appliances, mattresses, box springs, bikes, toys, misc. household items, etc.</li> <li><b>NOTE:</b> We do not pick up TV's, Tires, or Hazardous chemicals.</li> <li>Call 213-4700 at least 48 hours prior to schedule a pickup.</li> <li>Do not place items under trees, under overhead lines or cables, or next to fences, parked cars, or anything that could be damaged during the collection. If you then your items may not be taken.</li> <li>Items must be placed curbside, ally, or designated area Condo Association has for Bulk pick up by 7:00 am or the evening before requested pick up day.</li> <li>Items are picked up Monday- Friday on a scheduled basis.</li> </ul>	<p>All construction/ demolition and remodeling debris will be collected at a fee of \$158.65 per cubic yard for collection and disposal with a \$50.00 minimum charge. The total amount will e determined by the driver and will be added to your bi-monthly Utility water bill.
